## 7. Committee Reports:

## A) Community Request:

- 1) Financial request for a family that lost their home in a fire: Lion Christiane Zoidl
  - -The Executive approved financial aid in the amount of \$700 in grocery and gas gift cards
  - -the family was presented with the cards on Friday, the were very grateful
  - -they have received winter clothing from the Coats for Kids program
  - -the are staying at an hotel and are unable to find accommodation
- 2) Trinity United Church: Lion Mike Barker
  - -The minister has approached President Mike Barker to assist with the purchase of a commercial dishwasher at a cost of \$20,000, (\$10,000 of which has been raised)
  - -the dishwasher is used for the Lunch at My Place program (LAMP)
  - -the Executive Committee will discuss and bring a recommendation to the Club

#### B) Santa Fund/Lunch: Lion Kirby Brock

- -311 vouchers needed
- -1189 people including 475 have a need for assistance
- -approximate cost \$35,000
- -a committee meeting was held before the general meeting to discuss details of lunch
- -Lion Kirby will send out a duty roster later this week
- -Saturday evening set up to start at 8:30 p.m.
- -Sunday set up time is 9:30 a.m. if you are only serving food start up time is 10:15 a.m.
- -432 dental kits will be available on Sunday only
- -additional voucher distribution days are December 11 & 12 at Church of Christ
- -vouchers can be picked up between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. both days
- -2 shifts required at Church of Christ 10:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. And 2:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m.
- -a greeter is needed for both days at Church of Christ-see Lion Kirby
- -children's gift bags will be available on both distribution days
- -Maple Leaf hampers are to be distributed on Wednesday December 13, no driving -recipients must make arrangements to pick up their own hampers
- -vouchers are not available after Tuesday, December 12th
- -a suggestion was put forth to review Santa lunch/fund procedures as it is becoming unmanageable in general overworking the Committee Chairs in particular, and causing significant problems with lack of correct information from the Salvation Army
- -a suggestion was put forth that the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting in January be solely devoted to this issue

## C) Nutrition Program: Lion Kirby Brock

- -North Newmarket Lion Glenn Conduit has had zero luck getting help into the separate schools
- -the Newmarket Lions Club is supporting 360 children every day
- -\$3,500 has already been allocated for breakfast/lunch programs

## D) Seniors/Newmarket Residence Gifts: Lion Sylvia Brock

- -222 gift bags were assembled earlier today and delivered to Southlake Village
- -The Newmarket Residence for Adults gifts will be delivered on Thursday, December 7th
- -Mary Gardiner has generously made tags for the gifts to Southlake Village
- -Lion Marilyn Gray has acquired gifts for 6 seniors at Mackenzie Place-she will deliver and take photos

## E) Meal Kits: Lion Sylvia Brock

-120 meal kits and 30 celebration kits were assembled on November 27<sup>th</sup> and delivered to the Food Pantry on November 28th

#### F) Catch the Ace: Lion Rick Metcalfe

- -thank you to everyone who helped sell tickets on Black Friday (Lions; Ron, Brian, Bernard, Howard, Suzanne, Mary, John, Kirby and friend of the Club, Mars Hayward)

- -just over \$54,300 has been cleared for Camp Dorset
