1. Call to Order/Welcome: Lion Mike President Barker

2. Minutes of the July 24, 2023 Meeting:

Motion: Lion Kirby Brock- "That the minutes of the meeting of July 24th, 2023, be accepted as presented."

5. Zone meeting update: Lion President Mike Barker

- -cold dinner, sandwiches, salads, dessert, coffee, tea, and water
- -Regional Chair Vaughan Moult to notify Club the first week of September re: #'s and dietary requirements

6. Committee Reports:

A) CATCH THE ACE: Lion Don Gardiner

- -in the black, value of Ace is increasing
- -Lion Rick Metcalfe presented at Cabinet meeting-encourages other clubs in District to support the draw as it's for Lions Camp Dorset.
- -advertising material almost ready to disperse to interested A16 clubs for promotion
- -thinking of "Lions Day" to encourage other Lions to buy tickets? Could Eblast?
- -\$15,000 ready to donate to Camp Dorset

B) **COATS FOR KIDS:** Lion Christiane Zoidl

- -Sweatshirts and Sneakers event went well, approximately 125 people served
- -leftover items-adult items went to Newmarket Residence (facility for adults)
 - -children's items donated to Church of Christ for their holiday program
- -new home for Coats for Kids will be the basement of the Quaker Meeting House on Yonge St.
 - -will have to work out of bins, no place to hang items
- -present stock has been packed up
- -North Newmarket Club handling storage, we can assist if they request
- -new season starts October 7th goes until December 30th

C) SCHOOL REQUESTS: Lion Sylvia Brock

-school has not started yet

MAPLE LEAF PUBLIC SCHOOL:

-Action Table partnership

- -more of a neighbourhood activity than a school function
- -the program will be receiving \$8,000.
- -As the school's sponsor, the Club will be responsible for distributing the funds
- -will need to have funds available immediately, upon request.
- -suggestion is to put the funds in the Catch the Ace Account for quick access.
- take the added responsibility off the Treasurer
- -the Vice Principal (Karen Mahoney) oversees the program
- -the program should be finished by February 2024
- -October 3rd is meet the teacher night, school has asked for the club to do a presentation or have a booth for parents to access
- -November 16th is an Interview/Games Night, Lion Sylvia Brock to meet with school to iron out details

D) **GENERAL REQUESTS:** Lion Sylvia Brock

- Reminder of general guidelines-Club pays vendor directly, not person making the request
 -for medical requests, must have report from a doctor or health care provider and quotes
 from suppliers of equipment and a social worker should be involved
- 2) Blue Door requests a few cases of Ensure for a client -costs approximately \$100 per case

F) VISION: Lion Sylvia Brock

1) Vision Assessment Program

- -\$5,000 was designated for further vision testing for students who need the next level of assessment, 4 families made use of the funds
- -Dr. Patrick Quinn has been working with the University of Waterloo to see if the assessments can be covered by insurance
- -Lion Sylvia Brock met with Dr. Quinn and Valerie Kitzaki (Coordinator of Blind Low Vision & Deaf Blind Services for YDSB) to discuss the possibility that 1 of the 4 students who asked for

support, can be financially assisted by the Club to complete the 6 months program

- -to assist with further testing, the Club would require the family to make a total commitment and make some financial contribution
- -Lion Sylvia Brock to receive copies of the student assessments to see what process is involved

2) Vision Screening

- -to start again in November, looking at Wednesdays and Thursdays
- -health department has dropped off new equipment for the volunteers and a slide show
- -refresher with volunteers to be scheduled

7. Food Insecurity: Lion Kirby Brock

- -41% of Food Pantry users are children
- -Lion Kirby Brock would like the approval of the Executive to visit schools in Newmarket to inquire as to what they need for a food program
- -the Club provided snack funding for several schools last year
- -the Club is more interested in a breakfast program, not a snack program
- -Lion Kirby Brock, as a retired Principal, knows first hand how a good breakfast benefits a student
- -the North Newmarket Lions Club would like to assist

8. Guest Speakers:

- -Lion Sylvia Brock to contact Governor Sudha Verma to schedule a club visit
- -Danielle Gibb from Community Living of York Region to speak on October 2nd.

9. Swans:

- -email received asking for continued use of the Lions Hall for their meetings
- -starting September 11th, the Swans will meet on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of the month
- -suggest asking the Swans to help when the Club needs volunteers
