#### 6. Treasurer's Report: Lion Ron Head

- -Major expenses coming up e.g., Santa Fund, school breakfast programs
- -Club has approximately \$150,000 until year end plus monthly Bingo funds (June 30th)
- -with the cost of living and inflation expect people to donate less to the Santa Fund
- -Expect a lot more requests for Santa Fund assistance
- -no funds needed for Mulock Farm Park development; they have all the sponsors they need

# A) Catch the Ace: Lion Rick Metcalfe

- -after this series lottery tickets will only be available online and at a few sponsors
- its too much work for only 6 members, have to give up every weekend in the summer to sell tickets
- -may not make as much money with new procedure

- -Opens Saturday at 10

# C) School/Community Requests:

#### 1) Food Insecurity in Schools: - Lion Kirby Brock

- -Lion Kirby Brock is working with North Newmarket Lion Glenn Conduit on providing nutrition to schools
- -Lion Kirby Brock has been trying to contact Superintendent of Schools for YDSB, no luck so far
- -the Club is providing daily support to 180 school children
- -Lion Kirby Brock would like to contact other service organizations (e.g.Optimist Club) to help with providing funds for breakfast programs

#### 2) Maple Leaf PS BBQ- Lion Sylvia Brock

- -14 volunteers for Tuesday's BBQ and information event
- -2 people will man (people)? the information booth
- -the Health Inspector will be checking up on our procedures
- -expect to serve 500 hot dogs, includes 54 veggie dogs
- -families will have chips or coupons to exchange for the meal
- -Lions hats must be worn, see Lion Sylvia if you require one

## D) Santa Fund: Lion Kirby Brock

--Lion Kirby Brock has been meeting with Pastor Nathan of Church of Christ, he has volunteered his location if required, for distribution of food vouchers

#### E) Vision Screening: Lion Sylvia Brock

- -great response to Keaton Hamilton's Peace Essay contest win, many more people know that the Peace Essay is open to students with impaired vision
- -Peace Essay competitors must be sponsored by a Lion's Club
- -there is a new person at the YDSB, waiting for approval to start vision screening
- -apparently an equity issue, some schools/parent's councils complain to media if their schools aren't included in the screening program and want to deny all other children access
- -schools need at least 3 weeks to send permission letters home and get them returned
- -scheduling will be Wednesdays and Thursdays this year

# F) Community Meal: Lion Kirby Brock

- -hams have been purchased, usual meal to be prepared
- -5 members needed
- -preparation of meal only, no serving required
- -Friday November 10<sup>th</sup>

#### 8) Executive Recommendation: Lion President Mike Barker

- -recommend support International Director candidate, Lion Debbie Dawson's campaign with a \$500 donation

- will cost about \$40,000 to run the campaign
- -she came to the Zone meeting the Club hosted last week
- -the Club has supported 2 candidates in the past, so we have experience in running a campaign
- -Campaign will incur numerous expenses and many Clubs haven't recovered from COVID and don't have the funds to support the campaign

- -the children are doing well at school, but the family is struggling with trauma
- -looking into Salvation Army counselling
