#### 1) PJ's and Pancakes- Lion Kirby Brock

- -Friday September 22 at Southlake Regional Health Centre
- -volunteer list circulated
- -a celebration for paediatric cancer patients and their families (73 guests)
- -serving from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- -need a reader to read stories to children
- -park in the parking garage-bring ticket inside for validation

#### 2) School Breakfast Programs-Lion Kirby Brock

- -We have donated \$2,000 to Maple Leaf PS and Meadowbrook PS
- -180 children are now being supported
- -Maple Leaf PS has an agreement with the York Region Food Network to provide 75-100 meals per week
- -The North Newmarket Lions Club is supporting food programs at Prince Charles PS and Stuart Scott PS
- -Lion Kirby Brock is trying to secure a meeting with the Director of Education for York Region to see what else is needed to address food insecurity
- -concentrating on performance plus schools-schools located in economically challenged areas

#### 3) Action Table Partnership with Maple Leaf PS- Lion Sylvia Brock

- a) the staff and Coordinator of the program would like our Club to help get parents out to meet the Teachers night on October 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - -a BBQ will be provided to encourage families to come to the event and hopefully, find out what community resources are available to help them
  - -the Club will set up booths to showcase, vision screening, coats for kids, the Santa fund etc.
  - -9-10 volunteers needed
- **b)** November 16<sup>th</sup> is Parent /Teacher interview night and the school is hosting a games night -the school would like the Club to help out with the simple games

#### C) Effective Speaking: Lions Sylvia Brock and Kirby Brock

- -Trinity United Church has been booked for both March 2<sup>nd</sup> (Club's contest) and March 23<sup>rd</sup> (District Contest)
- -need French judges, please reach out
- -no Lions are permitted to judge at the District Contest
- -the Club had unbelievable success last year, sending 6 candidates who all placed, 4 were from Newmarket

#### D) Vision Screening: Lion Sylvia Brock

- -Volunteer list circulated
- -volunteer review to be help before start date

#### 8) Zone Meeting: Lion Mike Barker

- B) Santa Fund Vouchers- Lion Kirby Brock
  - -2022 voucher distribution cost the Club \$38,000 \$26,000 was received in donations
  - -the Era Banner has been discontinued, loss of advertising
  - -ask the North Newmarket Lions Club for a monetary donation
  - -expecting more families to apply this year, 62 families were missed last year
  - -current values: \$50 for 1 person

\$150 for 5 people
